- §1 HDMO Head of the Student Council Anahita Chavan declared the meeting opened at 12:22.
- §2 Time and Place Time and place was approved.
- §3 Approval of Agenda The meeting **decided**
to approve the agenda
- §4 Approval of Last Meeting Protocol The meeting **decided**
to approve the protocol from **2025-05-21**.
- §5 Information from external Representatives No further updates from external representatives.
- §6 Finished Courses Numerical Analysis, *FMNF05*: While the workload is deemed high, it is a clear improvement over previous years.
- Design of Systems for Digital Transformation, *EITA65*: Students were reminded to fill out the CEQs and the results will come later. One criticism the course will likely receive is that a large amount of content is spread out across the whole year.
- Software Development in Teams - Project, *EDAF45*: The course is well liked overall. Some students noted that testing is not taught thoroughly enough. A consideration is to hire TA (Teaching Assistants) to ensure that the groups are following the process and principles being taught. Some students disliked specifically the first part of the course consisting of lectures.
- Applied Mathematics - Linear systems, *FMAF10*:
- Complaints about the exam: The course used to be standardized, but with a new teacher, the exam has been changed. Additio-



nally, it is no longer open book. Half of the exam content has been altered. However, the course administrator argues that the changes have worked as intended.

The labs are not well liked and will be reworked. Among the planned changes, Maple may possibly be removed and Matlab replaced with Python. The formula sheet will also be updated if suggestions for improvement are received. People are very pleased with both the lectures and the lecturer.

Virtual Reality in Theory and Practice, *MAMF45*: A well liked course.

Theoretical Perspectives in Interaction Design, *MAMN50*: A demanding course worsened by the fact that the content didn't feel very relevant to the program.

Programming - Second Course, *EDAA01*: The CEQ meeting had few complaints to discuss as the course has been positively received. Anna Axelsson seemed receptive to new input on the course.

§7 Ongoing Courses

Discrete Structures, *EDAA75*: Difficult course with the first open book exam for the C program. Additionally, it's the first time Susanna Rezende is responsible for the course. We have gotten extra points for the homework assignment. If the assignments are a basis for the exam or test different skills entirely is unclear however.
