Meeting with the Program Board: 365 000 kr were distributed as followed for development and quality improvement:

- Interaction Design, *MAMF60*: Receive 115 000 kr to change the course structure based on the feedback from the CEQ surveys.
- Functional Programming, EDAN40: Receives 100 000 kr to improve the labs and to more closely align the content to Basics of Functional Programming, EDAF95. Additionally, the lectures will be looked over and the labs on moodle di-

gitized.

- Computer Organization, *EITF70*: Receive 96 000 kr to make the labs more practical and to more closely align the content with the previous course, Design of Digital Circuits *EITF65*.
- Remaining 50 000 kr will go towards funding repeat sessions for students who did not pass the exams in the second programming course, EDAA01.

Meeting with CS: Simply put, new people are getting hired.
