- §1 HDMO Head of the Student Council Anahita Chavan declared the meeting opened at 12:16.
- §2 Time and Place Time and place was approved.
- §3 Approval of Agenda The meeting **decided**  
**to** approve the agenda
- §4 Approval of Last Meeting Protocol The meeting **decided**  
**to** to approve the protocol from **2025-11-12**.
- §5 Information from external Studentprat with the Program board: Dec 3rd is the preliminary date. Replaces the regular SRD meeting.
- §6 Representatives Finished Courses The CEQs should be finished. 13-15 today, Filip Af Klinteberg will teach how to censor CEQs.
- Functional programming, *EDAF95/EDAN40* A couple of weeks ago functional program CEQ was held. Ideally, students should finish the course with a positive perspective on Haskell and functional programming, which is not largely the case. Hampus talked with the course responsible, Noric seems positive to changing the course according to feedback. The course has also received 100k SEK for improvement.
- OMD, *EDAF60*: The usual approval rate of around 75% went down to around 50%. The exam went very well for students who went to the optional seminars according to an anonymous survey. One of the projects you do during the course went on to take up a large part of the exam while not being highlighted during the course. A change in content made the exam more difficult.



Christian mentioned that there would be much more focus on the projects in this exam. Lambda functions had to be done completely correct. What caused this discrepancy in results from previous year?

§7 Ongoing Courses

- C1:

Calculus in One Variable B2, *FMAB70* - An unreasonable amount of questions are being put as suggested homework. Class reps will speak to the teacher and ask if they can split exercises between recommended ones and optional ones if you have extra time.

Introduction to Programming, *EDAB05*: The book contains many links that do not work in a physical format. Since the book is available online, it should be clearly stated. Anahita will raise this again with Björn.

- D1:

Calculus in One Variable B2, *FMAB70*: Some appreciate the large number of exercises available, while others are stressed given the large amount of material.

Introduction to Programming, *EDAB05*: There is a strong emphasis on purchasing the compendium, since Björn believes the physical book is vital to the success of the course.

Cognition, *EXTA65*: Is going well so far.

- C2:

No one present.

- D2:

Software Development in Teams, *EDAF45*: Students have a short deadline to register to four labs (one being a mandatory exercise session). Some students have received their course git, while others have not. Overall, all courses are going well.

- C3:

Nothing special to note, everything is going well.

- D3:

Much less fun study period compared to the previous, though things are overall fine.

The Business of Software, *ETSF25*: You're meant to have an even amount of people in your group to be able to form pairs. An exception for handling groups with an uneven



number of people would be great.

Mathematical Statistics, Basic Course, *FMSF20*: Few people go to the lectures. Confusing course.

- VR/AR: Computer graphics, *EDAF80* - We received our results, everything went well.

Interaction design, *MAMN25* - We have two deadlines each week, due to the time crunch the quality of the course work is poor. The attendance to lectures is low. Sounds like a CEQ discussion.

- Other courses:

Computer architecture, *EITF20* - A mistake in the instructions wasted a lot of time for some students, the lab session was at 8 in the morning and each lab presentation takes about 40 minutes to present. A lack of TAs made it difficult to get help while approving the groups.
